

## What does it mean to have a Banned Drinker Order (BDO)?

If you have a Banned Drinker Order (BDO), you may have some questions. This information is to help you know what you can do while on a BDO and where to find help if you need it.

### Can I drink alcohol?

No. You cannot buy or drink alcohol or have any alcohol for the time you have a BDO. If you get caught with alcohol, your ban can be made longer.

### Can other people give me alcohol?

No. They can be put on the BDR if they give you alcohol. People who give alcohol to someone with a BDO can be fined.

### Can I change how long I have a BDO for?

Yes. If you go to a support or treatment service and finish the program, you can ask for your ban to be made shorter.

### Getting help

- If you want to change the problems you are having with alcohol, you can get help.
- Some people need a safe place to stop drinking, this might be at a withdrawal place or a residential program.
- Some people need someone to talk to such as a counselling service.
