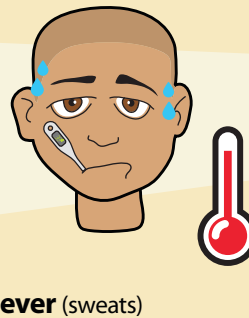


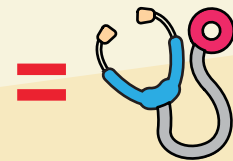
Invasive Group A Streptococcus (iGAS) infection

If you show signs of the following in the next 30 days

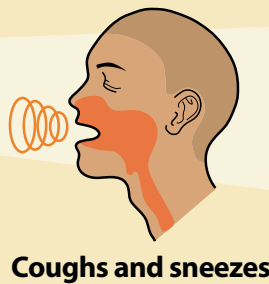
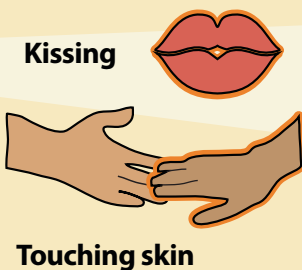

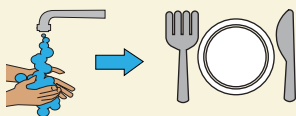
Visit the health clinic and say you are an iGAS contact

The infection can be easily spread through contact

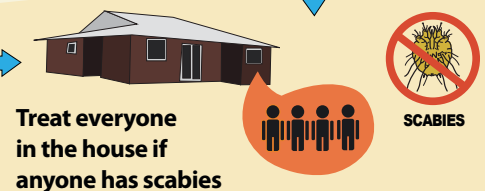
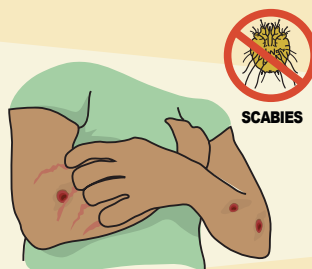
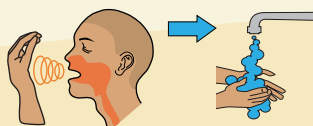


What can I do to STOP iGAS infections?
