Hoppys Camp Locality Volatile Substance Management Plan

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1. Background

The plan has been developed in accordance with the requirements of the Volatile Substance Abuse prevention Act (the Act) and represents the express wishes of residents within the area including the Lhenpe Artnwe Aboriginal Corporation, Alice Springs Police and Tangentyere Council.

The plan outlines actions that will be taken, and penalties attached to taking fuel, aerosol paint, and glue into the area that may be used to inhale a volatile substance.

2. The management area to which the plan relates

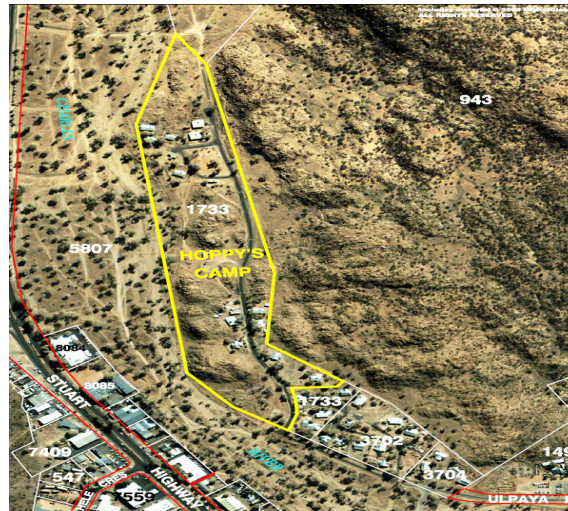
Volatile Substance Abuse Management Area - Hoppys Camp Locality

All that parcel of land in Alice Springs in the Northern Territory of Australia being that Part of Lot 1733 bounded by lines described as follows:

Commencing at the northern corner of lot 1733 bounded by lines: 147 degrees 11 minutes 77.195 metres; thence 168 degrees 25 minutes 462.42 meters; thence 184 degrees 42 minutes 40 seconds 152.89 metres; thence 127 degrees 05 minutes 30 seconds 135.29 metres along the eastern boundary of Lot 1733; thence 224 degrees 05 minutes 30 seconds 15.39 metres; thence 256 degrees 35 minutes 30 seconds 63.95 metres; thence 167 degrees 12 minutes 28.055 metres; thence 183 degrees 44 minutes 10 seconds 28.055 metres; thence 200 degrees 16 minutes 30 seconds 28.06 metres to intersect the south western boundary of lot 1733; thence 303 degrees 35 minutes 30 seconds 95.025 metres; thence 319 degrees 04 minutes 10 seconds 97 465 metres; thence 353 degrees 35 minutes 30 seconds 257.095 metres; thence 352 degrees 21 minutes 40 seconds 284.39 metres; thence 16 degrees 23 minutes 40 seconds 204.165 metres along the western boundary of lot 1733 to the point of commencement,

3. Practices and procedures relating to the management of the possession, supply and use of volatile substances and maximum penalties for breaches of the plan

Possession and use of fuel, spray paint and/or glue by a person engaged in volatile substance abuse.	Possession of fuel, spray paint and/ or glue by a person engaged in volatile substance abuse is not a contravention of the Management Plan.	Lhenpe Artnwe Aboriginal Corporation does not seek to make the possession of a volatile substance by a person who is engaged in volatile substance abuse a contravention of the Management Plan. Lhenpe Artnwe Aboriginal Corporation has expressed that it wants people who are at risk of severe harm from volatile substance abuse involved with treatment programs.	Police, health practitioners and family may request the Minister to apply for a treatment order for a person who is at risk of sever harm.	Nil
Possession and use of fuel that may be used to inhale a volatile substance.	No person in the management area will possess fuel other than indicated in the procedures.	Lhenpe Artnwe Aboriginal Corporation will erect signs visible to all traffic into and exiting from the management area advising the public of the management area, restrictions in place and penalties for breach of the plan. The management plan restricts the use of fuel that may be used to inhale a volatile substance in vehicles and/or machinery in the management area. Person/s suspected of possessing fuel that may be used to inhale a volatile substance for use in vehicles and/or machinery may be in breach of this part of the management plan. Person/s suspected of breaching the management plan will be notified to police by the person/s with the suspicion of the breach. Person/s with vehicles that were manufactured prior to 1986 or person/s with high performance vehicles and/ or machinery that is designed to run on fuel with a Research Octane Number of 95 or above (manufacturer's specifications) may seek written permission from the Lhenpe Artnwe Aboriginal Corporation to use Premium Unleaded Fuel.	Police will keep the identity of any person who provides information related to a breach of the management plan confidential at all times	100 penalty units or imprisonment for 6 months (A person must not contravene a management plan).

Possession and use of spray paint and/or glue that may be used to inhale a volatile substance	No person in the area will possess spray paint and/or glue other than described in the procedures	<p>Lhenpe Artnwe Aboriginal Corporation will ensure that all contractors, and other agencies and individuals in the area who possess spray paint or glue that may be used to inhale a volatile substance for work or commercial purposes shall secure such spray paint and/ or glue from unauthorised access at all times.</p> <p>Any contractor, other agency or individual who is suspected of failing to ensure the security of spray paint or glue that may be used to inhale a volatile substance may be in breach of this part of the management plan and will be notified to Police by the person/s with the suspicion of a breach.</p>		
<p>Supply of fuel that may be used to inhale a volatile substance.</p> <p>Supply of spray paint and/or glue that may be used to inhale a volatile substance.</p>	<p>No person will supply fuel that may be used to inhale a volatile substance to any person for any purpose in the management area.</p> <p>No person/s will supply spray paint and/or glue that may be used to inhale a volatile substance to any person other than indicated in the procedures.</p>	<p>Any person/s suspected of supplying fuel that may be used to inhale a volatile substance to any person in the area may be in breach of this part of the plan and will be notified to Police by the person/s with the suspicion of a breach.</p> <p>Spray paint and/or glue that may be used to inhale a volatile substance will only be supplied to another person/s by businesses registered to sell such items in the area.</p> <p>Persons, other than registered businesses suspected of supplying spray paint and/or glue that may be used to inhale a volatile substance to any person in the area may be in breach of this part of the plan and will be notified to Police by the person/s with the suspicion of a breach.</p>	<p>Police will keep the identity of any person who provides information related to a breach or suspicion of a breach of the management plan confidential at all times.</p>	<p>200 penalty units or imprisonment for 2 years (Unlawful supply of volatile substances)</p> <p>A person must not supply a volatile substance to a second person if the first person knows or ought to know the second person intends:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) inhale the volatile substance; or b) to supply the volatile substance to a third person for inhalation by the third person or any other person.

4. Amendment or replacement of management plan

In accordance with Division 3, section 51 of the *Volatile Substance Abuse Prevention Act 2005* the management plan may be amended or replaced:

1. Where a minimum of 10 residents of a management area, or a community council for a council area within which there is a management area or part of a management area, may:
 - a) prepare an amendment to the management plan for the management area; or
 - b) prepare a new management plan to replace the management plan for the management area.
2. Apply to the Minister for Health through the Department of Health for the proposed amendment to, or replacement of, the management plan.
